## SUBMISSION FROM ABERDEENSHIRE COUNCIL

- 1. While, as an Education Authority, we have no argument with the detail contained in the Bill it does appear to be particularly robust and covers all areas of good practice, we do have concerns about the existence of a separate Autism Bill.
- 2. Given that we already have a code of practice based on existing legislation Education (Additional Support for Learning) (Scotland) Act 2009 which ensures that all children and young people are provided with the necessary support to achieve their full potential, it is unclear what added value is provided by having a separate piece of legislation to cover Autism. Indeed, we would go so far as to say that it may be counter-productive to isolate a single condition like this.
