SUBMISSION FROM SCHOOL LEADERS SCOTLAND

- 1. School Leaders Scotland supports the Autism (Scotland) Bill.
- 2. This Bill will bring Scotland in line with the rest of the UK.
- 3. The National Audit Office identifies that £2.3b is currently spent on services and support for people with autistic spectrum disorder. The NAO calcuates that there will be a substantial saving by issuing guidance.
- 4. This Bill should result in better outcomes for those with autism.
- 5. An autism strategy will be helpful for those in educational and health services who are working with young people with autism.
- 6. The calculation that the Bill will not have any direct financial impact on local authorities is important at a time when local authorities are having to find significant savings.
- 7. One issue could be the short timescale of 4 months to develop the autism strategy following the Bill becoming statutory.
