Title of Instrument	The Road Works (Inspection Fees) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2009 (SSI 2009/74)

Purpose

1. These Regulations provide for an increase to £30.00 (previously £25.00) in the fee payable by undertakers for inspections of their work by road works authorities in Scotland under regulation 3(1) of the Road Works (Inspection Fees) (Scotland) Regulations 2003 and revoke a previous instrument which increased the fees in 2008.

Policy Objectives

2. The policy objective of this instrument is to raise the level of inspection fee payable from £25.00 to £30.00 with effect from 1 April 2009.
